Q3 - 2021

SPACs drove this quarter with over \$6 billion in deals in autonomous technologies, electric vehicle charging, and micro-mobility

- Self-driving startup Aurora will raise \$2 billion in SPAC merger
- 2. Digital freight platform Transfix to go public via merger with SPAC
- 3. EV battery maker SES Holdings to go public in \$3.6 billion SPAC deal
- 4. Gogoro will go public on Nasdaq after \$2.35B SPAC deal





# Selected SPAC Deals of the Quarter







Aurora is in talks to receive \$1 billion of development capital from Uber, PACCAR, Volvo Group Venture Capital, Reinvent Capital, Counterpoint Global, Index Ventures, Sequoia Capital, T. Rowe Price, Canada Pension Plan Investment Board, PRIMECAP Management Company, XN, Baillie Gifford and Fidelity Management & Research through a private placement as of July 15, 2021

Transfix, a digital freight platform, has entered into a definitive business combination agreement with G Squared Ascend I. The transaction implies a pro forma enterprise value for Transfix of \$1.1 billion. Upon closing, existing Transfix shareholders are expected to own approximately 69% of the combined company, with G Squared Ascend I stockholders owning approximately 24%

SES is in talks to receive \$200 million of development capital from GM Ventures, Hyundai Motor, Koch Strategic Platforms, Geely Automobile Holdings, Kia Canada, LG Technology Ventures, SAIC Motor, Fidelity Investments Canada, Vertex Ventures China, Franklin Templeton and Foxconn Technology through a private placement as of July 13, 2021




